Qualification Awarded

After successfully completing all the requirements and graduation requirements in the curriculum program, the students graduate with a degree in the field of "business Administration". Students who complete this section are entitled to obtain the associate's degree diploma and the title of Professional Personnel.

Admission Requirements

For Turkish Citizens:

(1) High School Diploma, (2) Placement through a centralised, nation-wide student selection and placement examination organized by Assessment, Selection and Placement Centre (ÖSYM). Candidates gain access to the programmes based on their composite scores consisting of the scores on the centralized exam and high school grade point averages.

For International Students

(1) High School Diploma and its "Certificate of Equivalency" granted by the Turkish Ministry of National Education (MoNE). (2) Exam for International Student (YÖS) or international university entrance examinations such as SAT I, ACT, etc., recognised by the national authority in higher education, the Council of Higher Education (YÖK). Candidates gain access to the programmes based on their scores obtained from YÖS or equivalent exams.

Higher Grade Transition

Students who graduated from Business Administration Program will be able to graduate from Banking, Banking and Finance, Banking and Finance, Labor Economics and Industrial Relations, Business Administration, Business Information Management, Business Informatics, Business-Economics, Logistics Management, Health Institutions Business, Capital Markets, Insurance, There are vertical transfer facilities to the undergraduate programs of Risk Management, International Finance, International Business, International Business, International Trade, International Trade and Finance, International Trade and Management, Management Information Systems.

Graduation Requirements

In order to graduate from the program, it is essential to take the courses in the program content, to be successful in the courses taken, to complete 120 ACTS and a weighted GPA of 2.00 in accordance with the relevant articles of the regulation.
