Admission Requirements

For Turkish Citizens: (1) High School Diploma, (2) Placement through a centralised, nation-wide student selection and placement examination organized by Assessment, Selection and Placement Centre (ÖSYM). Candidates gain access to the programmes based on their composite scores consisting of the scores on the centralized exam and high school grade point averages.

For International Students: (1) High School Diploma and its "Certificate of Equivalency" granted by the Turkish Ministry of National Education (MoNE). (2) Exam for International Student (YÖS) or international university entrance examinations such as SAT I, ACT, etc., recognised by the national authority in higher education, the Council of Higher Education (YÖK). Candidates gain access to the programmes based on their scores obtained from YÖS or equivalent exams.

Higher Grade Transition

Graduated students could be continue their study in Aviation Management, Business Administration, Logistics Management, Travel Management, Travel Management and Tourism Guidance, Aviation Management, Transportation and Logistics Programmess with exam (DGS).

Graduation Requirements

In order to be able to be graduated from the program, according to regulations, students need to be successful in the contents of the courses, and must complete these courses with 2.00 general grade.

Graduates will be able to be employed by THY, other private airline companies, airports, logistics and catering companies, Ministry of Transport, Republic of Turkey Directorate General of Civil Aviation, Republic of Turkey General Directorate Of State Airports Authority, Ground Service Companies, Air Force.
